- Monitor, share, and archive press coverage of mental health policy and events in target states.
- Assist with campaign collateral development, helping draft and package materials for partners and advocates.
- Support digital research, outreach, and engagement, including monitoring online conversations and identifying opportunities to amplify messaging.
- Contribute to rapid-response efforts as campaign needs evolve.
- Perform additional tasks as assigned to support the broader campaigns and communications team.

- Understanding of effective social media content creation and digital storytelling.
- Familiarity with Facebook, Instagram, X, and LinkedIn for advocacy and engagement.
- Proficiency with Canva.
- Strong online research skills.
- Reliable follow-through and attention to detail in managing tasks and deadlines.
- Flexibility and willingness to support a fast-moving, campaign-oriented team.
